Climbing Flooring System Cost Estimator Checklist

We're here to help! We are always available to walk our customers through the process of gathering the necessary information that enables us to build the best possible custom flooring system for each facility. Please don't hesitate to contact us with any questions or concerns, or for clarification on any of the items listed below.

Futurist offers on-site measurement of your facility as an alternative to conducting the measuring process yourself. We will visit your facility and accurately measure your space using our custom laser system as well as coordinating with you to obtain all items on this checklist. If *Futurist* conducts the measuring process a fee for labor and travel will be assessed. Please contact us for an estimate on this added service.

- Provide any existing documentation (electronic preferred) of the layout of your facility including:
 - Blueprints
 - CAD or other electronic drawings
 - Wall manufacturer drawings
 - Sketch-up files
- Take photos of your entire facility. The more specific images we have, the more accurate your estimate will be. Taking photos in sequence and labeling them is helpful. Please include:
 - Existing climbing flooring systems (drag mats, carpet bond, gravel, shredded rubber, wood chips, dirt, etc.)
 - Wall footprint images
 - All doors that come in contact with flooring area (Do they open in or out?)
 - Entry/exit points of pedestrian traffic to flooring areas
 - Any areas where access beneath mat is necessary
 - Description of building flooring substrate (i.e. wood, concrete)
- Prepare electronic or paper rendering of facility with the following labeled:
 - Measurements of flooring area and borders
 - Wall characteristics/footprint information (i.e. height of vertical footboard, approx. angle of wall from top of footboard at each location where the angle changes)
 - Wall height
 - Pedestrian traffic flow patterns throughout facility
 - Entry/exit points to flooring areas
 - High-traffic landing zones
- Identify any areas where you prefer incline mats to preserve footboard height.
- Identify preferred number of seams/pad configuration.
- Identify preferred color of your flooring system (we can provide vinyl color samples or visit futuristclimbing.com).

NEW FACILITIES/EXPANSIONS

We can work with your wall provider to coordinate flooring and wall designs and delivery times to ensure the most cost effective options for your new facility or expansion project. **When planning your facility**, you will want to take into consideration the following:

- Adequate flooring budget
- Coordination of wall footprint with flooring design/layout
- Flow of facility traffic (members, guests, spectators)
- Space allocation: ample coverage area/pad edge set-back (see Flooring Standard Comparison Sheet)
